
The church and hall floors have now been resealed and polished with products formulated to provide a non-slip surface for premises used by the elderly and infirm. A representative from the manufacturers visited St. Paul's to view the premature damage and excessive wear to both church and hall floors. He could not fault our scheme of works and commented that they had not previously seen such a well worked out and detailed plan. However he made a few minor suggestions which we have incorporated and have put down a thicker film of polyurethane varnish which we hope will provide a more durable finish. We have done a lot of work to ensure that the products we use, and the method of application, are suitable for users of our church and hall.

John and Tony can recommend working on the floor as an alternative to attending Weight Watchers - however we have no intention of setting up in competition.
