Summer services at St. Paul's

We want to find a pattern that will suit most of our worshippers. For the past few years during the summer months at St. Paul's we have held a single combined Sunday morning service. This year we will be holding the combined service at 10.00am but only during the school holidays. For June and most of July we will continue with the normal pattern of 8.45am and 10.30am services. Then on 25th July, we change to the single 10.00am service for six weeks. In September we return to the normal separate services.

Sunday 8th August will be 'WALK/BIKE TO CHURCH' Sunday.

At the APCM we were considering ways of reducing our carbon footprint as the Dorcan Church. One suggestion was that we designate a Sunday when as few cars as possible are used to travel to church, and alternative forms of transport are used instead.
