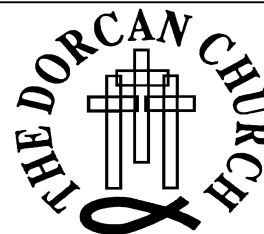
Cantores chamber choir is celebrating its 20 year anniversary with a concert at

 **Trinity College Bristol** Trinity College Bristol offers a part-time training programme for the Certificate in Theology validated by the University of Bristol.

The next course will begin in September and will take place during evenings and weekends at Trinity College Bristol. This is a two year programme. Classes will take place on Tuesday evenings once a week and four Saturdays per year. In addition some units each year will be taught as a single week. Each teaching unit will take place over 8 weeks, with breaks for school half-terms, Christmas and Easter. These classes will enable the student to complete 120 credits. Prospective students will be invited for a short and informal interview as part of the application process. An Open Evening and interviews will take place on 5th July 2011.
