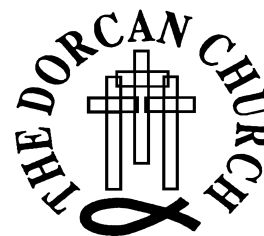
Following feedback from customers, The Real Easter Egg has undergone some improvements. These improvements are:
