St. Paul's Flooring and Partition Screen - update

Church Council met recently and agreed to proceed with a modern, hard-wearing, wood effect laminate flooring for the church and hall at St. Paul's. Formal approval from the Diocese is being sought, and plans are being made for the floor to be installed in the period June to August. You may recall that this had been the original choice of Church Council last year, before the possibility of a natural oak floor was explored at the recommendation of the Diocese. This latter option proved too costly for our insurance claim, and the Church Council gave unanimous approval to the choice of this laminate.

You will appreciate that this is a complex task, involving not just the removal of the existing floor, but also the removal of the organ, church furniture and radiators into storage and then re-installation. Our plan is to complete the hall section first, followed by the church, allowing us to have one of these spaces available for most of the period for use for church services as well as for community groups who use our building.

Plans are also being put in place to replace the partition screen with a 'movable wall' made up of 10 sections, and we are trying to arrange for this to be installed at the end of March/early April. Fuller details can be found in the copy of the report discussed at Church Council and which is now displayed in both churches. My thanks particularly to Tony and Diane for all their hard work on this, but also to others on Property, Finance and Centre Management Committees, and to Church Council. Please do speak to one of us if you have any further queries. Thank you. Andrew
