**Visit of Nick & Kate Wooding**

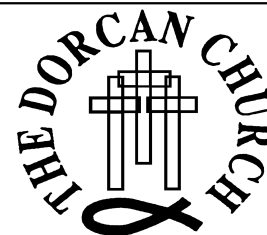
Our CMS Mission Partners, Nick and Kate, are coming on a short visit to the UK soon.
