Her funeral will be held at Kingsdown Crematorium at 12noon on Monday 1st December and all are welcome to come. The family would like to extend a warm invitation to a gathering immediately after the service at Fizwarren House.

Welfare funding: The government is currently consulting on how local welfare provision should be funded in 2015 to 2016, and is looking at ceasing emergency hardship funding. This will severly affect the vulnerable in our society who are already struggling with the changes in the benefits systems. Over 3,000 people in Swindon have had the need to access this hardship funding over the last year.
