Dec. 11th Evening meal - everybody. (Christmas) All men welcome.

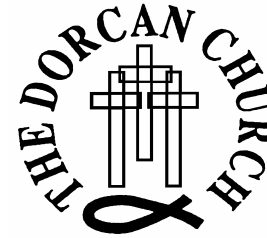
