Chapel at St Paul's – work on floor continues

The old flooring in the Chapel at St Paul's is putting up strong resistance, but the contractors are still expecting to have the new floor laid in the Chapel by the end of this week. The current expectation is that we can probably return to use the Chapel for services etc from Sunday 2nd July, though it will still be a little while before some of the church furniture, the organ and the radiators can be re-installed.

It is hoped that the new partition screen will be installed on 3rd to 4th July. Work to replace the floor in the hall will begin on Monday 17th July for the following couple of weeks, during which time a number of our regular community groups will meet in the chapel.

Please take extra care as these works continue, and as there is some small disruption to the usual pattern of activities. Thank you for bearing with us, as we look forward to the completion of the works by early August, and to being able to make full use again of our newly-refurbished premises.
